

# Wide Triangle Scarf

A very easy pattern, great for beginners and using up relatively small amounts of yarn. Every row is exactly the same, you can just keep knitting until it's the desired size or you run out of yarn.

Finished Measurements: 40 inches by 9 inches for a small scarf

Yarn: sample knit with Bernat Softee Chunky, using most of one skein

Needle Size: 10 US / 6 mm

## **NOTES**

As this is knit from the point out, it's easily adaptable to any weight yarn.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

K = knit

st = stitch

YO = yarn over (increase)

## **PATTERN**

Cast on 3 stitches.

Row 1: K1, YO, knit to last st, YO, K1

Repeat this row until scarf is desired size or you run out of yarn.

Bind off VERY LOOSELY.

Fringe may be added if desired.
